The Rocky Mountain Section-AAPG each year chooses a K-12 teacher of earth and resource science to represent the section in a competition held by the American Association of Geologists the following year. RMS also presents its Teacher of the Year with \$2000 and an expense paid trip to the RMS Meeting in the year of selection.

At the AAPG national level, the winner of the Excellence in Teaching Award personally receives \$3,000 and their school also receives \$3,000. In addition, the winner gets an expense-paid AAPG meeting to receive the award. Additional information about the national award can be found at --

Qualifications for the Section Award:

- nominated by a local affiliated geological society,
- have at least three years full-time teaching experience and currently teach at a U.S. K-12 school,
- teach one unit per year on natural resources (unit must fit the definition of natural resources).

Materials needed from a nominated teacher are:

- statement of teaching philosophy,
- description of the unit on natural resources,
- letter of recommendation from a colleague, and
- letter of recommendation from an administrator.
