Awards for Contributions or Achievements Nomination Form on Opposite Side

Robert J. Weimer Lifetime Contribution Award

Lifetime Contributions recognizes contributions to the practice of the geosciences and/or petroleum geology in the region of the Rocky Mountains. This award was first given in 2013. The Lifetime Contributions Award is similar to the national AAPG Sidney Powers Memorial Award, the AAPG's most distinguished award.

RMS-AAPG Distinguished Service Award

The Distinguished Service Award is presented to members who have distinguished themselves in singular and beneficial long-term service to RMS-AAPG, with emphasis on long-term and at the same time, meaningful service to the Association.

John D. Haun Landmark Publication Award

Rocky Mountain Landmark Publication Award recognizing the authors or editors of a book, guidebook or other publication that over the past decade has had exceptional influence on developing new hydrocarbon plays or deeper understanding of fundamental geology within the Rocky Mountain region. The first award was given in 2013.

Outstanding Young Professional Award

The Outstanding Young Professional Award is presented to a person with less than five years of experience who has made significant contributions to the industry through volunteering to AAPG, RMS-AAPG or RMS-AAPG affiliated society or by scientific achievement including publication, presentation, or other contributions to geology. This award was first presented in 2015.

Julie Lefever Memorial Award

First presented in 2017, the RMS-AAPG created the annual Julie Lefever Memorial Award in recognition of those who have done an exceptional job at sharing geoscience knowledge with the science community and/or general public.
